78% of IT employers in Canada said they are facing difficulty finding the talent they need¹

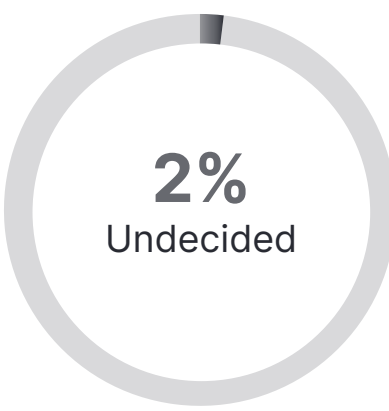


IT & Data skills are the most challenging to find, regardless of industry and geography¹

The IT Industry Employment Outlook

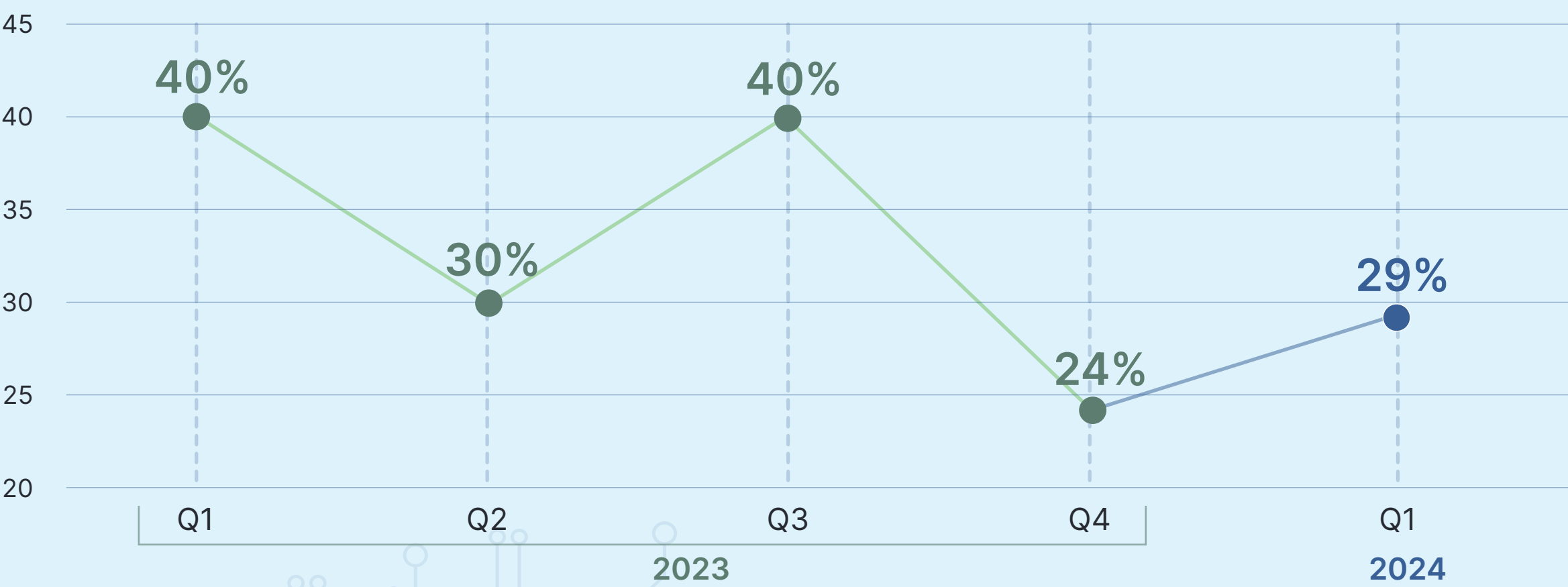

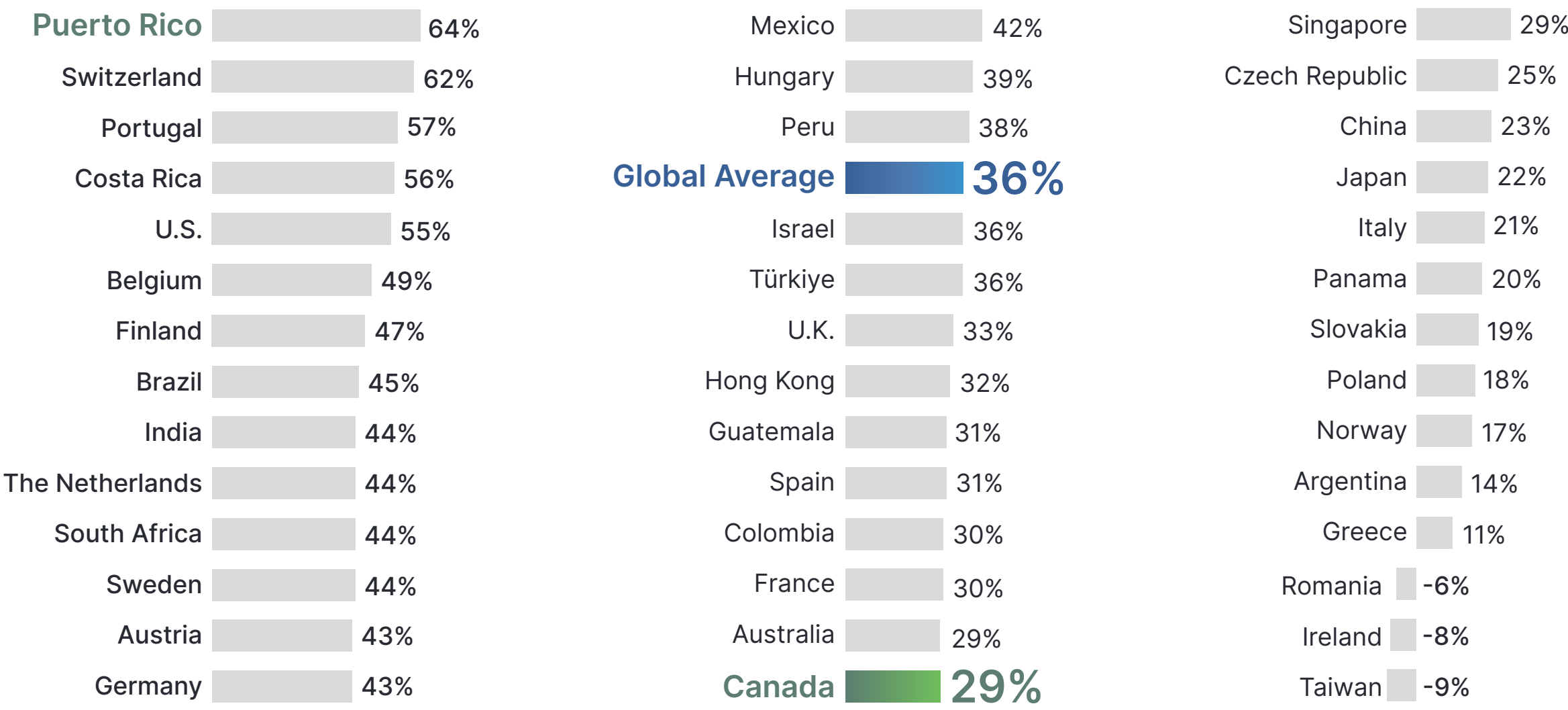
Changes Over Time

IT Hiring demand increased by +5% since the previous quarter but decreased (-11%) when compared to the same time last year.

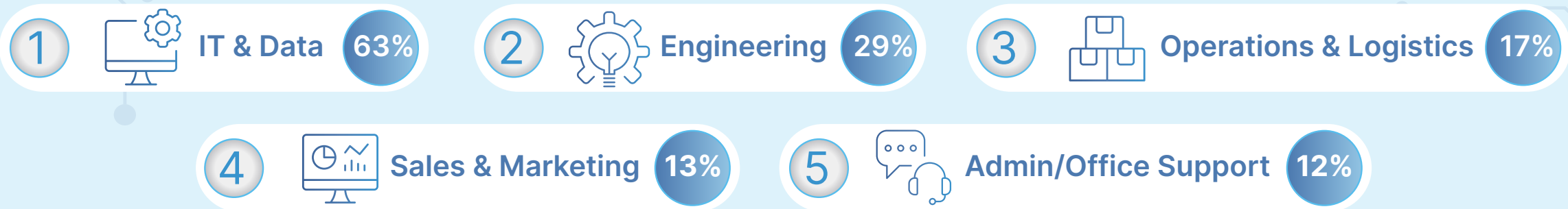


IT Hiring Expectations for January – March
