## **The IT Industry Employment Outlook**

Used internationally as a bellwether of labor market trends, the Net Employment Outlook – calculated by subtracting the percentage of employers who anticipate reductions to staffing levels from those who plan to hire – now stands at 29% in Canada.









## **Changes Over Time**
